As part of the **EU Cities Mission**, the Mission Platform managed by NetZeroCities has been supporting **112 Mission Cities** selected by the European Commission as they strive to reach climate neutrality by 2030. Building on this work, we are now extending peer-learning opportunities and access to online resources via the NetZeroCities Portal to all cities across Europe and Horizon-associated countries that are not part of the 112 Mission Cities but aim to advance towards climate neutrality.

This supports the EU Cities Mission's second objective: **ensuring that Mission Cities act as hubs of experimentation and innovation, enabling all European cities to become climate-neutral by 2050.**

- **The Climate Transition Map**, a strategic tool guiding cities across sectors to overcome challenges and achieve climate neutrality.

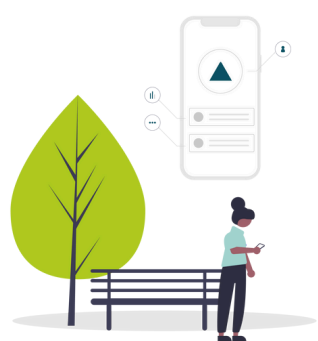
