The Climate City Contract (CCC) is the documented result of co-creation and commitment processes to 2030

Commitments - Overview

- WHAT: Contract between the municipality and diverse stakeholders that establishes new ways of working together to reach 2030 climate neutrality
- WHY: to identify key priorities and accelerate climate action through concrete commitments and alignment of efforts across key actors and sectors
- **WHO**: city administration, stakeholders from the public, private and third sector, citizens and local communities

Local, regional and national levels

• Why this format: so that a city as an entire ecosystem can commit together to act and hold each other accountable

Political commitment + stakeholder commitments









Commitments - Structure







2030 Climate Neutrality Action Plan

The objective is climate neutrality by 2030

The basic design principles to develop the Action Plan are:

- You are not starting from scratch: Build on existing strategies, plans and processes
- Rooting in deep stakeholder and citizen engagement
- Build on data-driven analysis and visualisation to inform policy makers and the public
- Portfolio approach to cluster sectoral climate actions and implementation and maximise synergies
- Link to **Investment Plan**





2030 Climate Neutrality Action Plan - Draft Structure







Aligned with Climate Neutrality Action Plan

The Investment Plan should not be mistaken for the Action Plan, but a Plan aligned with the Action plan, since the two will impact each other

Thinking for the Long Term

This Investment Plan is a long-term planning exercise and not short-term operational budgetary planning

Involves Multi-stakeholder Participation

This will involve contributions from the city administration, as well as outside stakeholders – including private actors

Acting as a Catalyst

The Investment Plan will act as a catalyst to optimize capital and help cities seek more funding & financing



Iterative Process

The Plan will be an iterative process, grounded against a set of indicators and reviewed at regular intervals

Focus on Financial Planning

This will be through providing the city with cost, impact and capital allocation guidance

City-Wide Approach

This holistic approach ensures all assets in the city are captured for purpose of decarbonisation

Public and Private

This Investment Plan captures both the public and private sectors

When and How to Start



- A rolling process: start when you can
- Validation still TBD but don't let that stop you This is about **more than the Mission Label**
- Links with other validation schemes are being explored/finalised
- Ask youself the question, what barriers to overcome? **How can the CCC** *enable what my city finds hard?*
- Process will be **different in each city** City Advisor role to tailor support and help navigate support offer
- **This is your journey but you are not alone**: other cities, advisors, consortium
