## Features of the CoP

### JOIN OR CREATE SPECIALISED CHANNELS:

These specialised channels provide a platform for in-depth discussions and collaboration on targeted issues, fostering deeper engagement and expert exchange. ### POST ON THE PORTAL

- **Ask for ideas:** Engage with the community to brainstorm, seek advice, or gather support for your initiatives. Whether you have specific questions or are looking for general input, the CoP offers a rich environment for collaborative problem-solving.



### SHARE KNOWLEDGE:

Share your expertise and best practices with the community by uploading documents and files to the group. Simply click files > upload file > document.

### JOIN & CREATE EVENTS:

- **Participate in webinars and trainings** hosted by the CoP, and designed to provide valuable insights and knowledge. Stay tuned for upcoming in-person events and feel free to share any events that might interest CoP members. To join an event, simply click on it in the calendar, visit the event page, register, and join by using the provided meeting link.
- **Organise your own online or in-person events** and invite the community to join. Whether it's a webinar, workshop, or a meetup to discuss specific topics related to climate neutrality, we are here to help you set it up!
