Short description

Scope of LGD

- The LGD focuses on reducing emissions, exploring the sale of waste heat to district heating, advancing sustainable practices across supply chains, and participating in a regional waste management pilot project. It also emphasises cross-industry knowledge sharing, regulatory support for climate-reducing projects, and public promotion of climate achievements. Overall, the collaboration aims to drive emissions reduction, resource efficiency, and widespread sustainability efforts within the region.

Concrete measures/commitments

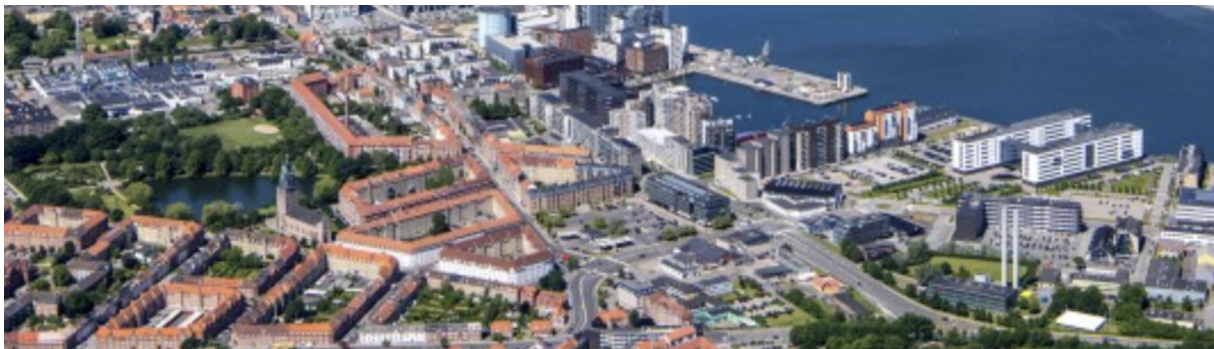
- The municipality of Aalborg commits to supporting regulatory processes for climate-friendly infrastructure and facilities, assists in exploring waste heat sales for district heating with Fibertex, and facilitates dialogue and a potential waste management pilot project among regional producers. They further commit to organising cross-industry networking events for climate collaboration and promoting Fibertex's climate achievements on various communication platforms.
- The Fibertex Personal Care A/S commits to collaborate with Aalborg Municipality to explore waste heat sales for district heating, engage with customers and suppliers to promote environmental responsibility and set green standards. In addition, they commit to actively participate in a regional waste management pilot project with other companies and contribute to knowledge sharing through networks and forums provided by Aalborg Municipality.

Scope of LGD

- The Local Green Deal agreement (LGD) aims to foster a collaborative framework between the city of Aalborg and cultural institutions like the Kunsten Museum of Modern Art to accelerate the transition toward a sustainable, low-carbon future. The agreement supports Denmark's national climate goals of reducing greenhouse gas emissions by 70% by 2030, with the ultimate objective of achieving climate neutrality by 2050.

Concrete measures/commitments

- The municipality of Aalborg commits to supporting the Museum by organising network events to inspire and facilitate new partnerships, provide guidance on climate and sustainability matters, and assist in calculating potential CO2 reductions
- The Kunsten Museum of Modern Art commits to a thorough environmental and climate assessment, preparing climate accounting in line with Greenhouse Gas (GHG) protocol principles and, a detailed action plan outlining specific sustainability initiative
