Short description

The Local Green Deal (LGD) in Galați focuses on transitioning the city's taxi fleet to electric vehicles, contributing to improved urban air quality, lower emissions, and quieter streets. In partnership with Taxi Albertini Galați, the municipality aims to modernise the transport sector by investing in EV infrastructure and supporting fleet electrification. This LGD supports Galați's broader sustainability strategies and sets a replicable model for other Romanian cities seeking climate-neutral mobility.

Scope of LGD

- This LGD supports Galați's Strategy for Sustainable Development and Plan for Sustainable Urban Mobility by targeting taxi fleet electrification and expanding EV infrastructure. It aims to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, attract green investment, and improve public health by reducing urban air and noise pollution.

Concrete measures/commitments

Galați Municipality commits to:

- Installing charging infrastructure comprising a minimum of 45 charging stations with two charging points each.

Taxi Albertini Galati (Albertini Speed ND SRL) commits to:

- Increasing investments in electric and non-polluting means of transport.
- Expanding its fleet of 4 EVs to at least 10 units by 2030 (up to 15% of its total fleet).

Scope of LGD

- This LGD supports Galați's Strategy for Sustainable Development and Plan for Sustainable Urban Mobility. It addresses key sustainability objectives by electrifying the public transport fleet, installing charging infrastructure, and promoting awareness among citizens. The project aims to reduce greenhouse

gas emissions, enhance public health, and create a more equitable and efficient urban mobility system.

Concrete measures/commitments

Galați Municipality commits to:

- Increasing investments in electric and non-polluting public transport vehicles
- Procuring a minimum of 40 electric buses and 10 trams by 2030
- Installing charging infrastructure at depots and strategic transit nodes (4 rapid charging and 8 slow charging stations with dual ports)
- Securing funding from public, EU, and national sources for zero-emission fleet procurement
- Ensuring implementation of public transport education campaigns in schools and city-wide communication during European Mobility Week

Transurb SA commits to:

- Transitioning its fleet from fossil-fuel-based to electric and non-polluting vehicles in line with Galați's sustainability goals
- Supporting infrastructure adaptations and readiness for electric bus deployment across its depots
- Leading operational execution and managing the electrified fleet
- Hosting open days and public education events showcasing green fleet technology and benefits
- Collaborating with schools and community stakeholders to increase adoption and support for sustainable transport.
