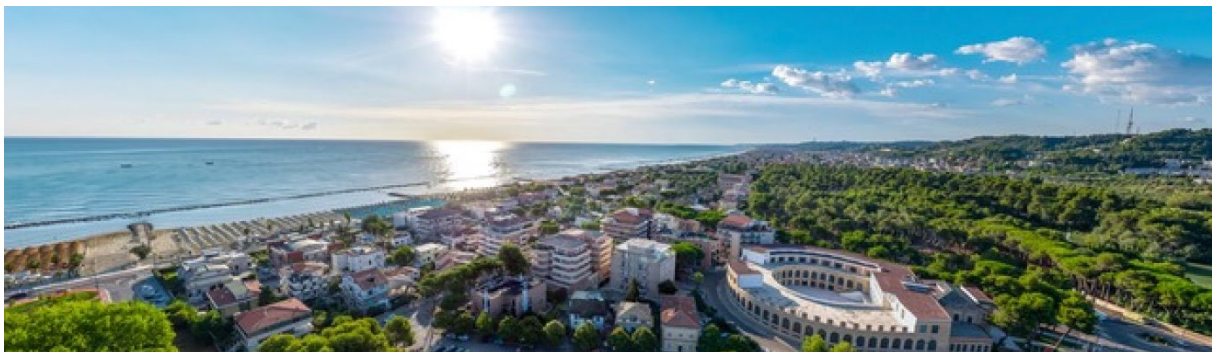

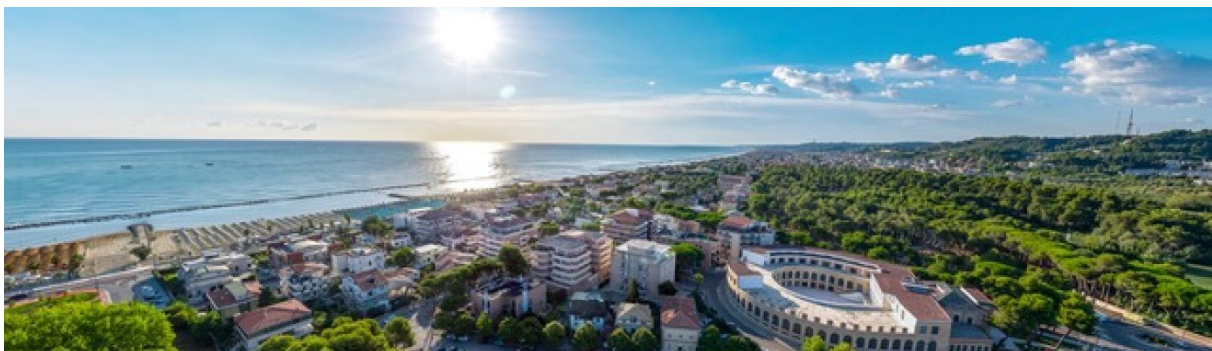

Together for Energy Transition & Climate Change Mitigation

Pescara - Italy

Short description

The municipality of Spoltore has approximately 20,000 inhabitants and is located in the province of Pescara. Like Pescara, Spoltore is also going through an important phase of economic, social and administrative transition in view of the merger with the neighbouring municipalities of Pescara and Montesilvano. In particular, Spoltore is currently engaged in carrying out all the actions and necessary for the start-up of the associated management of certain services citizenship with the municipalities of Pescara and Montesilvano. The Municipality of Spoltore is also engaged in the implementation of European and national policies and strategies, especially in the field of environmental and energy sustainability, translating them into concrete actions that influence and improve the quality of life of citizens. The LGD between the 2 cities, with also the contribution of third parties, includes mutual commitments to improve the environmental sustainability and wellbeing of their respective local communities by promoting renewable energy, energy efficiency in municipal buildings and the dissemination of sustainable practices and behaviour, also in view of the forthcoming administrative merger of the entities and the consequent associated management of some functions and services fundamental for citizenship. Main commitments are: - the integration of public services of general interest at municipal level - then recognition of cycle paths, their adequacy connecting Pescara and Spoltore and, if necessary, promotion of their increase or completion also for the territorial coverage of public transport for home-work journeys - Making citizens aware of the use of public transport for home-work journeys, also by promoting car sharing and the use of electric or conventional bicycles - Dissemination of opportunities offered by CER Pescara, identification of the most suitable areas for the realisation of photovoltaic systems, such as the roofs of municipal buildings and possible public funding for the installations compatibly with current legislation.

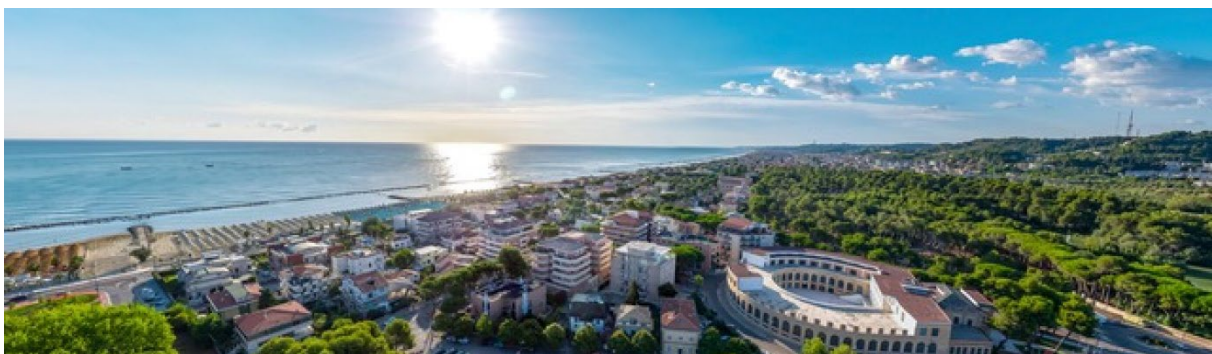

Short description

This Local Green Deal (LGD) is a collaborative agreement between the Municipality of Pescara and the Municipality of San Giovanni Teatino, aimed at advancing the energy transition and climate change mitigation. It focuses on promoting renewable energy, energy efficiency, sustainable mobility, and public engagement, while preparing for the administrative merger with neighbouring municipalities. The LGD includes joint actions, knowledge sharing, and the development of Renewable Energy Communities (CERs), with the goal of reducing greenhouse gas emissions, enhancing local sustainability, and improving the quality of life for citizens. The LGD contributing to the city's Sustainable Energy Action Plan - target: climate neutral by 2030.

Scope of LGD

- The LGD aims to foster collaboration between neighbouring local authorities to accelerate the transition to renewable energy and reduce greenhouse gas emissions. It includes shared commitments to improve environmental sustainability, energy efficiency, and promote sustainable practices, particularly in light of the upcoming administrative merger of Pescara with Montesilvano and Spoltore. The agreement also seeks to enhance coordination between councils and engage citizens, especially students, in environmental awareness and sustainable development

Concrete measures/commitments

Municipality of Pescara & Pescara Energia Spa (by 2030)

- Support the energy transition and reduce GHG emissions through concrete actions.
- Promote the creation and expansion of CERs, especially CER Pescara.
- Share best practices and provide training for energy efficiency and renewable energy, particularly targeting municipal buildings and schools.
- Collaborate on improving cycle paths and public transport coverage between municipalities.
- Promote car-sharing and the use of electric or traditional bicycles for commuting.
- Organise citizen awareness campaigns on sustainable commuting.
- Facilitate training sessions for the staff of both municipalities.
- Organise joint meetings (at least 4 per year) to plan and monitor activities.
- Share know-how through cooperation with experts (e.g., from ICLEI or ICC).
- Act as a founding member and facilitator of CER Pescara.
- Participate in the joint sustainability team to coordinate LGD implementation.
- Help identify suitable public rooftops for PV installation and seek public funding.

Comune San Giovanni Teatino

- Improve energy efficiency in municipal buildings, prioritising schools.
- Conduct a reconnaissance of cycle paths and improve or complete missing links.
- Promote sustainable transport, especially for home-work commuting.
- Verify and strengthen public transport coverage.

- Encourage citizen participation in CERs.
- Share information and benefits of CER membership with the community.
- Promote training and awareness on renewable energy and sustainability.
- Join the joint sustainability team and attend regular planning meetings.
- Allocate municipal resources and staff to implement LGD actions.
- Use all already committed funds as outlined in related municipal resolutions.
